## Personal data protection policy

The information collected by the port is subject to data processing to allow the port to respond to your request, to send you information, and/or maintain customer relations. The fields marked with an asterisk are required for your request to be processed.

For the ports of Golfe-Juan and Nice, the authority responsible for data processing is the Nice Côte d'Azur Chamber of Commerce and Industry (20 Bd Carabacel - CS 11 259 - 06005 NICE CEDEX 1, represented by its President).

For Port Vauban, the authority responsible for data processing is SAS Vauban 21 (Avenue de Verdun – Port de Vauban – 06600 Antibes, represented by its CEO).

For Port Gallice, the authority responsible for data processing is SAS Gallice 21 (Pointe du Croûton - 47 Boulevard Edouard Baudoin - port Gallice - 06160 Juan-les-Pins, represented by its CEO).

In the context of contractual relations relating to concessions or public service delegation of the port concerned, some of your personal data may be transmitted to the licensing authority (the Port owner).

For Port Vauban and Port Gallice, the Nice Côte d'Azur Chamber of Commerce and Industry is required to have access to the data in its capacity as a subcontractor, within the meaning of the GDPR.

Your personal data are kept for three (3) years after the end of your contract, your last call at the port or your last contact with the port. The data will be kept for ten (10) years based on requirements relating to accounting, tax and legal obligations. If you do not respect your payment obligations, you may be listed on an "exclusion list". In this case, your information will be kept for the duration of the litigation process and until all avenues of enforcement have been exhausted. In accordance with the Data Protection Act of 6 January 1978 and the European Data Protection Regulation (2016/679) of 27 April 2016, you have the right to access, to correct, to delete, and to transfer your personal data, to restrict and limit processing, and to organise the fate of your post-mortem personal data. These rights may be carried out under the conditions of the data protection regulations.
